### ***Vaccine Index:***

- **Chickenpox:** 1<sup>st</sup> dose given individually, 2<sup>nd</sup> dose given as a combo vaccine with MMR (MMR/Chickenpox)
- **DTaP/Polio:** Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis, Poliomyelitis
- **DTaP/Polio/Hib:** Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis, Poliomyelitis, Haemophilus Influenzae type b; series of 3-4
- **Hepatitis A:** series of 2
- **Hepatitis B:** series of 3
- **HPV:** Human Papillomavirus; series of 2 (if given before age 15)
- **MenACWY:** Meningococcal meningitis, types A, C, W, and Y; series of 2
- **MenB:** Meningococcal meningitis, type B; series of 2
- **MMR:** Measles, Mumps, Rubella (1<sup>st</sup> dose given individually, 2<sup>nd</sup> dose given as a combo vaccine with Chickenpox)
- **MMR/Chickenpox:** Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Chickenpox (given for the 2<sup>nd</sup> does for both MMR & Chickenpox)
- **PCV13:** pneumococcal conjugate; series of 4
- **Rotavirus:** series of 3
- **Tdap:** Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (for children 7 or older)
